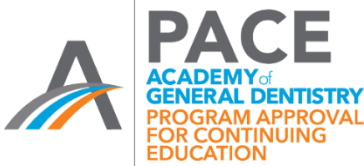

Course Description: Historically, Endodontics has been viewed as a prescription-based specialty. It revolves around performing root canal therapy. Significant confusion and challenges still exist in performing this procedure. Complex nature of root canal morphology and intricate knowledge of it can make pathway for stress free root canal procedure. This case-based presentation will go through a step-by-step approach in identifying and preparing root canals. This presentation will rather focus on the systematic approach to root canal system than talking about a root canal file system.

- Overview on how to identify Root Canal system.
- Overview of approaching and performing Root Canal.

Dr. Pushpak Narayana earned his BDS degree from Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences in Bengaluru, India. He serves on the faculty of the Rutgers University School of Dental Medicine as an adjunct associate professor in the Department of Endodontics, where he teaches postgraduate residents.

Directions to the Embassy Suites in Altamonte Springs: Exit east off of I-4 at S.R. 436 (E. Altamonte Drive) and turn left at the first traffic light, which is Cranes Roost Blvd. Proceed one block to the traffic light at Shorecrest Drive, and turn left.
